The Attorney General's Human Rights Guidance (The Use of the Irish Language) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019  
An tOrdú um an Treoir ón Phríomh-Atúrnae ar Chearta an Duine (Úsáid na Gaeilge) (Tuaisceart Éireann) 2019

*Made* - - - - *16th July 2019*

*Coming into operation* *1st October 2019*

The Attorney General:

- (a) has, in pursuance of section 8(1) of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004<sup>(1)</sup>, issued guidance on international human rights standards relevant to the use of the Irish language, in respect of the Police Service of Northern Ireland and the Public Prosecution Service for Northern Ireland;
- (b) has, in accordance with section 8(3)(a) of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004, published that guidance on his website;
- (c) has, in accordance with section 8(3)(b) of that Act, laid that guidance before the Assembly<sup>(2)</sup>;
- (d) has, in accordance with section 8(1A) and section 8(5A) of that Act, consulted the Advocate General for Northern Ireland<sup>(3)</sup>.

The Attorney General, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8(3)(c) of that Act, makes the following order:

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Attorney General's Human Rights Guidance (The Use of the Irish Language) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 An tOrdú um an Treoir ón Phríomh-Atúrnae ar Chearta an Duine (Úsáid na Gaeilge) (Tuaisceart Éireann) 2019 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2019.

**3.** The guidance on international human rights standards relevant to the use of the Irish language, in respect of the Police Service of Northern Ireland and the Public Prosecution Service for Northern Ireland, shall come into operation on the day on which this Order comes into operation.
